The sappy, penetrating finish clings with strong tenacity and a suave, building floral quality.

Picks up a smoky note with air and finishes impressively long and broad, with resonating spiciness and excellent clarity. I'll bet that this complex wine would be an interesting ringer in a flight of Meursaults.
